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SANTA EULÀRIA IBIZA MARATHON

COVID-19 Preventive Guide

Health guarantee policy

Given the pandemic situation caused by the COVID-19 and fully aware of the need to ensure the safety and health of people, in the Santa Eularia Ibiza Marathon we understand as a priority the celebration of an event in which you can enjoy the sport with health guarantees.

Therefore, before, during and after the event we will adopt the necessary and appropriate preventive measures.

Basic principles:

- Social distance.
- Personal hygiene.
- Hygiene of the competition areas.
- Mandatory use of masks.
- Quick action in case of possible symptomatology.
- Access control in the delivery of bibs and at the start.

Runner's Fair

At the Runner's Fair and delivery of bibs, to be held at the Palacio de Congresos de Ibiza in Santa Eularia, an outdoor area will be set up where a single point of access to the site will be created.



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At the access point, the temperature will be taken and hydroalcoholic gel will be dispensed.

Runners must pick up their race bibs at the designated point. Hydroalcoholic gel will be available at the bib pick-up points and queues will be managed to ensure a safe distance (with signs on the ground). In addition, the staff will be properly equipped with masks and, if necessary, gloves.

The enclosure must be walked in the direction indicated, maintaining at all times the safety distance and wearing the mask.

Specific measures

1. The delivery of bibs will be carried out keeping the safety distance.
2. Delivery points will be established at which the queue will be managed with boundary posts with cords or retractable extensible tape, as well as with markings on the ground indicating the distance of 1.5 meters between people.
3. The bib will only be given to the registered athlete.
4. The bib will be delivered, together with the rest of the necessary materials, in a closed envelope or bag (to be defined) to avoid the manipulation of the materials.



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5. The staff delivering the bibs will wear a mask and, if necessary, gloves. In addition, they will have hydroalcoholic gel at each delivery point.
6. The athlete will come to pick up the bib wearing a mask and having completed the self-declaration.

Checkroom

Due to health restrictions that prevent us from offering the usual checkroom service, we will provide an alternative option that will allow us to avoid contact.

A single checkroom point will be set up at Passeig de S'Alamera, next to Santa Eularia beach. It will be open during the same hours as the Runner's Fair so that the athlete can deposit his/her bag/backpack.

Once the race is over, the athlete will be able to pick it up at the same point, thus avoiding the manipulation of the bags.

Start

The start will be managed with four starting boxes. The access will be at the back of the starting box, one on each side.



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Access to the box will be with a mask and after taking the temperature. Please come early enough to take into account this process.

Start line protocol

1. The access to the starting box will be closed at 15:15 h.
2. The recommendations of the organization, which will be transmitted by the speaker, must be followed.
3. All runners must wear a mask and must run with it for the first 200 meters of the course.
4. The start will take place simultaneously.

Specific measures to control access and exit of the competition

1. The start time will be brought forward to 15:30 h.
2. Participants will be informed, well in advance, of the instructions to comply with all safety regulations before and during the start.
3. Access to these areas will be managed by the organization's staff, duly equipped with mask and gloves.
4. At the access control, the organization staff will take the temperature of each athlete with a non-contact thermometer. Above 37.5° the temperature will be repeated. If the same temperature is repeated, or higher, access will not be allowed and the athlete will be taken to the medical service to implement the Covid-19 protocol of the health authorities.



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5. The access control to the starting box will be managed by the organization's staff, duly equipped with a mask.
6. In the starting area there will be specific personnel to remove waste (including masks that athletes may have thrown).

Provisioning in the race

Avituallamiento en carrera

1. The number of refreshment points along the course will be minimized.
2. At the 4 points provided, the refreshment area will be extended to avoid possible crowds.
3. The staff at the refreshment points will be properly equipped with masks and gloves.
4. Each refreshment point will have hydroalcoholic gel, paper rolls and waste paper baskets.
5. The staff will limit themselves to replenish the tables without coming into contact with the athlete.
6. Liquid refreshments will be served in compostable cups.
7. Solid refreshments will be incorporated at the refreshment points. Only food in individual cups or unpeeled fruit (bananas) will be provided.
8. Each refreshment point will have a container and specific personnel for waste collection and management.

Finish line

The finish area will be delimited with fences or natural elements.

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The runner must put on a mask before crossing the finish line. If you do not have it (you have lost it or thrown it away), the organization will provide you with one after crossing the finish line.

There may be media in a delimited space.

Specific personnel will be available to avoid the accumulation of runners and to prevent them from stopping. Their mission will be to lead them to the starting area.

Specific finish and post-finish measures

1. The finish tape shall be properly disinfected and, if used more than once, the disinfection process shall be guaranteed between each use.
2. A direct access to the medical care area shall be provided.
3. The area for the media shall be delimited and they shall wear masks as compulsory.
4. Athletes crossing the finish line will be directed immediately to the post-finish area respecting the safety distance.
5. In the post-finish area, and in one or two individual rows (depending on space), each athlete will be given a closed pack with his medal, and supplies (solid and liquid), which must be opened outside the enclosure.
6. The post-meta area will have hydroalcoholic gel, paper rolls and paper garbage cans.
7. The organization's personnel working in the finish and post-finish area will be properly equipped with mask and gloves.



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8. In the post-finish area there will be containers and specific personnel for waste collection and management.
9. An exit will be set up in the post-finish area and the direction in which to circulate will be clearly marked to evacuate the participants and prevent them from accumulating in this area.
10. In the adjacent areas there will be security personnel to prevent the formation of groups and remember the recommendation to maintain the safety distance.

Awarding of prizes

1. The awarding of prizes will be limited to the absolute classification: first three and first three. As well as the first three relay: male, female and mixed.
2. The prize-giving area will have a totally closed perimeter.
3. Only athletes who will be on the podium, the accredited media, the authorities who will present the awards and the organization's staff working in that area will be allowed to be in the area.
4. The prize-giving area will have hydroalcoholic gel, paper rolls and paper garbage cans.
5. Prize-giving procedure:
 - a. One person, wearing gloves and mask, prepares the trophies.
 - b. The trophies are placed on a table or tray.
 - c. The authority, equipped with mask, will take the tray and offer the trophy to the athlete. If he/she prefers to present the trophy, he/she must wear gloves.



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d. The athletes on the podium will wear a mask, except at the moment of the photo.

Discharge of responsibility

Before the competition, each participant must accept a disclaimer stating the following:

1. That he/she is aware of the Covid-19 protocol of the Santa Eularia Ibiza Marathon organization.
2. That he/she undertakes to comply with all the rules and recommendations of said protocol, as well as the indications of the authorities or the organization's staff present at the competition in order to avoid possible contagions of Covid-19.
3. That he/she agrees not to attend or participate in the competition if he/she suffers from symptoms that may be compatible with Covid-19. Nor will he/she participate if persons with whom he/she has had contact suffer from such symptoms.
4. That he/she knows and accepts that there is currently an objective risk of contagion of Covid-19 with the consequences that may arise from it.
5. That he assumes that the organization of Santa Eularia Ibiza Marathon, depending on the evolution of the situation, may adopt the necessary measures to ensure the development of the competition in a safe environment in order to avoid contagion by Covid-19.



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6. That, if infected by the Covid-19, the participant exonerates the organization of any responsibility in relation to possible damages or harm that may arise for his person.

7. That the application of extraordinary measures or decisions to preserve the health of persons during the sporting event may not be considered as a breach of the essential obligations of the organizer, which means that it may not require the payment of amounts, compensation, or refund of prices or amounts in respect of registration or participation fees or costs incurred by the athlete.

8. That, if the participant fails to comply with the safety rules and / or instructions of the staff of the organization and the authorities, may be excluded or disqualified.

General considerations

The presentation acts, press conferences or complementary activities to the sporting event may be carried out, provided that they are necessary and that the application of all security measures and social distance is guaranteed.

Participants, workers or volunteers with symptoms compatible with Covid-19 and/or with a temperature above 37.5° will not be allowed to enter the competition area.

Spectators



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1. No specific areas of access to the public will be enabled to avoid crowds in marked areas. No bleachers or similar structures shall be set up.
2. Spectator movements shall be marked with signs on the ground to ensure that they move in one direction only.
3. Work shall be done to facilitate the minimum distance between spectators.
4. The use of the mask is not mandatory outdoors, unless the safety distance cannot be guaranteed.

Athlete services

1. There will be no activations at the expo.
2. There will be no physiotherapy or muscle recovery services.
3. Medical services will be reinforced.
4. No changing rooms will be provided.
